### Lumberjack Competition



- Stock Chainsaw Class Chainsaw will be provided at the contest; all competitors will use the same saw.
- 2.70cc and over Chainsaw class Competitors will bring their own saws. The same saw cannot be used by more than one competitor.
- 3. <u>Under 70 Chainsaw class</u> Competitors will bring their own saws. The same saw cannot be used by more than one competitor.
- 4. <u>Single Buck sawing competition</u> Competitors are encouraged to bring their own saws; a saw will be available for competitor's use, if necessary.
- 5. <u>Cant Hook Log Rolling competition</u> Competitors can bring their own cant hook or use a provided cant hook.
- 6. Crosscut sawing competition Competitors are encouraged to bring their own saws. A saw will be available for competitor's use, if necessary. Since this is a team event, points will not be awarded toward the overall standings. Prize money will be awarded to the top three teams.

Each event will pay the top three places:

1st Place - \$50 2nd Place - \$30 3rd Place - \$20

Points will be awarded for 1st through 10th place in events 1 - 5.

The competitor with the highest point total will be the overall winner. Competitors must compete in at least 4 events to qualify for the Champion Lumberjack prizes. Competitor's best four event scores will count towards their point total.

Champion Lumberjack awards:

1st Place Overall - \$300 2nd Place Overall - \$200 3rd Place Overall - \$100

Grand Prize will be awarded based on point total from this event and the FFA Fest event in October.

- All chainsaw classes will be a two cut format.
- Competitors will start with both hands on the log with the saw at idle on the ground.
- The first cut must be a down cut and the two cuts must be completed within 4 inches from the end of the log and all disks must be intact for a qualifying time.
- Chainsaws must be "stock appearing" with no piped exhaust or modified air filtration.
- All Chainsaw competitors must wear chainsaw chaps or chainsaw pants and eye protection in order to compete.
