8:00am August 15, 2025: Fair entry is OPENED back up for <u>registration</u>

Additional exhibits can be added to your account on the day you bring in your exhibits as needed. Also, onsite registration will be available if you are unable to do an online entry, so no need to worry, we will take care of you!

NON-PERISHABLE exhibit entries will be accepted on Saturday August 16, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. Non-Perishable and Perishable exhibits will be accepted Sunday, August 17, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Exhibits should be brought to the Farmer's Market — Wholesale side, 2nd entrance, 1st bay. (1st entrance is Retail/Direct Sales).

PHOTOGRAPHY INFORMATION



Photography Rules:

*Please NOTE: The photography rules may be changed per the photography committee

- Articles must be the work of the person in whose name they are entered.
- All photographs must be taken from August 2024 to August 2025.
- Youth may enter the adult categories but will be judged as adult. Black and White photographs can be entered into any category.
- Entries are judged on appearance, composition, tone, balance,

clarity, contrast, and suitability to category entered. Color photos will be judged on range of tones or contrast.

- Only one entry per exhibitor per category.
- Photos must be 8 x 10's only or 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 photo paper.
- No decorative borders, no frames.

** Photos can be securely mounted on 11 x 14 black foam core BEFORE they are entered, or you may PURCHASE the black foam at the time of registration
